<b>4 Prices</b>		
4.1	Prices for the individual services	1 direct transshipment (truck to train or train to truck) of 1 swap body or similar, incl. shunting: CHF 52, 1 additional crane operation in the terminal without shunting: CHF 35.
4.2	Discounts	No discounts will be granted.
<b>5 Access conditions</b>		
5.1	Legal requirements	Network access is granted to third parties in consultation with the operator. Inquiries about the capacities available must always be made by the service recipient. Swap bodies and containers must have rail certification and be codified accordingly. In principle, dangerous goods can be handled, but not all classes of such goods are accepted. Inquiries about the permitted classes and the notification process must be made in advance. Drivers must receive prior training in the codes of conduct in force in the terminal. Access to the terminals is conditional on these codes of conduct and the security regulations being met. Shunting of the handover group in the terminal is carried out by Swiss Post shunting staff/resources. The use of the terminal is recorded in a written contract.
5.2	Technical conditions	Only swap bodies measuring 7.45 m are currently handled. Other containers/receptacles up to 45 feet which have the same lifting point for the cranes can also be handled. Containers with a bulk weight of up to 16 t can be handled.
5.3	Shunting conditions in the facility	Shunting of the handover group in the terminal is carried out by Swiss Post shunting staff/resources.
5.4	IT systems	Swiss Post will equip swap bodies that are regularly used for transshipment with transponders at its own expense to simplify internal processes. Existing customer data will be handled confidentially.

6.2	Allocation of capacities	The terminal is used predominantly for parcel transport for Post CH Ltd, which is to be given priority treatment due to the performance mandate from the Confederation. Inquiries about free capacity can be made by contacting the above. In the event of capacity bottlenecks 1st priority: parcel transport 2nd priority: third-party customers (on receipt of inquiries)
6.3	Planned capacity restrictions	As of April 2020, there are no planned concrete capacity restrictions
