Early access to incoming mail every day

With the "P.O. Box" service, you can receive your letter mail early every morning. In many locations, A Mail items are delivered to P.O. Boxes by the time counters open in the morning. A P.O. Box also ensures secure storage and a discreet address.

As a customer, you benefit from various P.O. Box options, regardless of how much letter mail you receive a day. You can choose the location of your P.O. Box wherever you would like in Switzerland. A maximum of one "Standard" P.O. Box and one "Separate" P.O. Box is permitted per person.

How to open and manage

You can apply for a P.O. Box at the post office counter or online. You can benefit from more affordable conditions if you order online. This can be managed via the "Manage P.O. Box" online service in the "My Post" customer portal. Detailed information can be found at www.swisspost.ch/manage-postofficebox.

Set-up

P.O. Boxes are always put into operation on a Monday. The application deadline is always the Tuesday of the previous week. You will always receive four P.O. Box keys. To ensure maximum security, the keys may not be copied.

Delivery times

- A Mail: until counters open in the afternoon or according to local conditions
- B Mail: during the course of the day
- Registered mail is collected during local post office opening times

Access and emptying

As a rule, access to the P.O. Box is guaranteed round the clock. Customers usually empty their P.O. Boxes once a day or at least once a week.



Addressing and delivery

To ensure that addressed letters reach your P.O. Box quickly and securely, it is important that the second last line of the address includes the note "P.O. Box" and that the last line includes the post-code, town and any additional number for the corresponding P.O. Box location (if available). This helps avoid delays in the delivery of letters to your P.O. Box.

Please note that a domicile address is required for parcels to ensure delivery.

Examples of correct addressing for letter mail:

All persons/businesses recorded at your domicile address must be registered at your P.O. Box as joint users (private individuals) and sub-addresses (businesses). If a sub-address is cancelled, incoming letter mail will be returned to the sender. This will take place irrespective of whether or not the business on the private letter box is written to.
